The event aims to nurture, build, and celebrate the greater visual and performing local arts community. Expected attendance: 3-5,000.



World Music Fest

World Music Fest is an annual event featuring music and art from around the globe with an emphasis on showcasing regional artists – a celebration of culture and diversity. Through the universal language of music and art, this annual event builds bridges within the community, provides a platform for excellent local musicians and artists, and shows that there is a whole world within the place that we call home. Expected Attendance: 3,000-5,000 people.
